### **Experienced Music Teacher (from 28<sup>th</sup> August 2017- 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2018)**

Bordeaux International School has a vacancy for a well-qualified and experienced teacher of music to small groups of motivated students in a truly international environment.

Suitable candidates should be native English speakers and have previous experience and a thorough knowledge of the **University of Cambridge Examination syllabus**. They should also show enthusiasm for music and the ability to inspire the same enthusiasm in high school students.

The candidate should:

- Have a strong knowledge of the Cambridge International IGCSE and A Level syllabus and be able to confidently deliver the IGCSE and A Level music programme
- Work with group classes in order to prepare for two school shows.
- Be able to demonstrate flexibility and to create music to suit the annual school theme.
- Be creative and to recognise the international element of the school's identity in terms of programme planning and repertoire choice.
- Be able to arrange music rapidly in order to serve the rapidly-changing profile of the pupil cohort.
- Employ differentiation to ensure that pupils from all musical and cultural backgrounds are properly served in class.
- Teach to the standards of excellence expected from an international school.
- Be able to specialise in one instrument and be able to guide beginners in others.
- Be an excellent team player, working co-cooperatively with other staff in the language, humanities, art and drama departments.
- Work in liaison with the Primary and Early Learning departments to ensure unified and cohesive presentations.
- Be familiar working in popular, classical and world music styles.

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The duties will include creating interesting, motivating and differentiated lesson plans, preparing and delivering lessons, creating and supervising activities for students, evaluating student performance, maintaining classroom records, meeting with parents, teachers and other professionals and participating in general school events.

We are offering a part-time position (3-4 days maximum) with a minimum of:

- 14 hours per week of lesson teaching:

- Private tuition to a student cohort of over 100 students delivered within the school day or after school (6-14 hours per week minimum, depending on numbers interested).

Salary: **1100€** gross per month (base salary : from end August - mid June)

Plus potential for additional salary of up to **800€** per month from private tuition lessons (plus profit sharing scheme for all employees).
